

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

In order to earn an OSSD a student must:

- earn 30 credits—18 compulsory credits and 12 optional credits
- complete 40 community involvement hours
- successfully complete the Ontario Secondary School Literacy requirement

Compulsory Credits

- Students must earn 18 compulsory credits. Compulsory credits are determined by the Ministry of Education.

Optional Credits

- Students must earn 12 optional credits. Optional credits are determined by the student based on their pathway plan and post-secondary destination in consultation with parents and with support from guidance counsellors.

Graduation Requirements Checklist

1	Group 2: an additional credit in health and physical education, or the arts or business studies, or French as a second language, or cooperative education.	<input type="checkbox"/>
1	Group 3: an additional credit in science or technological education or French as a second language, or computer studies, or cooperative education	<input type="checkbox"/>
