Earning the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

To earn the OSSD, students will:

- earn 30 credits (18 compulsory and 12 optional)
- complete a minimum of 40 hours of community involvement activities
- successfully pass the literacy requirement
- earn at least two online learning credits

Compulsory Credits

 Students must earn 18 compulsory credits. Compulsory credits are determined by the Ministry of Education.

Optional Credits

 Students must earn 12 optional credits. Optional credits are determined by the student, based on their pathway plan and postsecondary destination. Course selection should be completed in consultation with parents/guardians and CVS guidance.

Reminder

 Many courses have required prerequisites. Students may contact CVS guidance if they have any questions surrounding prerequisites.
